Connie and Frank Merandi, co-owners of Coni & Franc in downtown Morgantown, were brought together decades ago by two weddings.

And through their store, they have been supplying beautiful garments for weddings and other special events ever since.

Although the couple attended WVU at the same time and knew many of the same people, they didn't meet until after college, when Connie was working in a clothing store called Designer for You.

Connie remembers when Frank brought in a photo album from his sister's wedding to show the store's designer, who had worked on the bride's ensemble. The designer wasn't in, so Connie "graciously sat down with him and looked through the album and told him how beautiful the bride was, and that I would relay it all to the designer."

A few weeks later, Connie was slated to attend a family wedding.

"Frank knew I would be there, so he asked his aunt, who was a guest, if he could be her plus-one," Connie recalled.

Frank asked Connie to dance at the wedding, and then she invited him to a family

Christmas celebration.

"We started dating after that," Connie said.

Frank and Connie had an inkling that they had good business chemistry together, as well as romantic. In 1982, they had an opportunity to buy a clothing store on upper High Street that, at the time, was geared towards juniors and separates. But they soon decided to take the store in a different direction.

"My mother sat down at the beauty shop and she listened to all these mothers complaining that there wasn't a prom dress to be had in Morgantown," Connie said. "There were a few places, but there wasn't a variety. So she came home and she said, 'you should go to New York and buy a whole bunch of prom dresses.' So the next week, Frank and I got on a plane and brought in evening gowns from all of the collections that we loved and we knew that so many people traveled outside of Morgantown to get."

Within a year of the store's opening, Connie and Frank were married.

"We figured that if we could handle businesses and family and everything else that we would have a successful marriage," Con-

nie said. "And of course, we were in love. Frank has great conversation, he has great style. The customers all love to get his opinion on what they are putting together. He also is a fabulous cook and he plays the piano. We complement each other very well. We have three beautiful children and a grandchild. We're very lucky.'

Coni & Franc soon grew larger than just the two of them, with Connie's mother, aunt and sisters all pitching in to make the business a success. Several years after the store opened, Connie and Frank were able to purchase the storefront at 422 High Street, where Coni & Franc is currently located.

"It's a beautiful space," Connie said. "It was built over 100 years ago, and it was meant to be a clothing store."

Though they gutted and renovated the space in recent years, many of the original fixtures remain. The business began with prom and evening gowns but is now best known for beautiful, timeless bridal fashions that families will look back on with fondness.

Consultation appointments can be made by phone 304-296-9466 or through the website https://www.coniandfranc.net/book-online, but Connie noted, "I always anticipate enough staff to handle walk-ins. We don't turn anybody away."

The store is open from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Monday through Friday, 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Saturdays, and is closed on Sundays.

During a consultation, Coni & Franc staff ask a lot of questions about the event in order to be efficient when assisting patrons. They provide dresses that are flattering to many different body shapes and sizes.

"We hope to help make our clients" visions come true," Connie said. "I want to make sure that when they see those pictures, they will think, 'I look so good'.'

Connie and Frank are involved in the Morgantown community and are appreciative of all the support they have received in return over the years.

"We are grateful to people who are willing to shop local," Connie said. "That is how small businesses stay in business."

Highgate: 'Unlike any place around'

From horse stables to a retirement home to nearly being torn down, Highgate Carriage House has a history that now includes a historical venue to host weddings and other events.

"Highgate is unlike any place around," said Tyler Kovar, wedding and event coordinator at Highgate. "We offer our guests a way to step back in time and forget the outside world. We may be located in downtown Fairmont, but you would never know it inside our gates. When you step on our grounds, you can have a special event space or that fairy tale wedding you've always wanted."

Highgate, at 830 Walnut Ave., Fairmont, is now owned by Cheri Satterfield.

Kovar provided some background on the facility.

"Highgate Carriage House began as a heated horse stable," he said. "It was built in 1909 for coal baron James E. Watson. Downstairs was home to the horses and upstairs were rooms for the servants."

In the 1920s, the estate was owned by St. Joseph Diocese in Wheeling. It was sold in the 50s to the Ross family and the main house became Ross Funeral Home with the carriage house being used as a retirement home.

Two brothers decided to split the prop-

erties in the 80s, Kovar said. The brother who had the carriage house was going to sell it to a fast-food chain that had plans to tear it down, but a group — Friends of Highgate — was able to save it.

Satterfield has owned the carriage house since 2014.

Over the years, renovations have been done inside, but the grounds have been maintained with some gardens added as well as an event tent to accommodate larger weddings and events.

"The outside of Highgate really takes you back in time," Kovar said. "To maintain that look and add the beautiful gardens makes the experience of Highgate a very unique one. We have a beautiful stone wall and staircase on the grounds that has been here since it was built. Couples walk outside and gasp at how beautiful it is. It is important to keep all the elements of the original grounds because nowhere around here has anything like that."

Highgate can accommodate 150 people inside and the outdoor tent 300. It does not offer on-site catering or require people to use specific vendors. Kovar said they do have a resource list of local vendors they've worked with and shares that with anyone asking.

It was originally located in the Morgantown Mall under the ownership of Charlotte Michael. In 2014, Michael decided to seek another owner for the business she had built.

At that time, Helen Squires was a long-time manager at a local restaurant. One day, Michael, a frequent patron of the restaurant, asked Squires if she was interested in taking over ownership of Lavish Boutique.

"Owning a formalwear store was never in my plan," Squires said recently. "Although, who doesn't love to get dressed up?" she added.

"But it just happened. It was a moment thing. I felt it. I want it. And I am in it. I literally agreed to it the next day."

To gain valuable hands-on experience, Squires worked with Michael in the store during the busy 2014 prom season. Then, in May of that year, Squires became the sole owner.

"Looking back, I'm very impressed." Squires said with a hint of wonder. "I never realized I was that fearless.'

In 2019, Squires made the decision to move the business to a new location – 525 Suncrest Towne Centre Drive, which had enough space to expand Lavish's bridalwear selections.

"The upgrade was a really big deal. It is a prime location to attract customers," Squires said.

But, shortly after the move was completed, the world began to change as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

"It was very, very difficult. We weren't on our own feet yet," Squires remembered. Early in the pandemic, weddings were postponed and proms were canceled, which made owning a formalwear boutique a bleak prospect. However, The New York Times reported that 2.5 million weddings are expected to take place in the United States in 2022, a substantial increase over the 1.3 million in 2020 and 1.93 million in 2021.

Squires has seen an uptick in business this year, particularly in wed-

"People haven't forgotten how to celebrate their journey with their loved one," she said. "We can never compare it to before the pandemic because we are living in a new world. So we can only compare it to 2020 and 2021," she said. "So long as each year is a bit better than

last year, then that's what we are shooting for."

In addition to bridalwear, Lavish is an authorized retailer of high-end prom and evening gown labels and also carries semi-formal garments for any special occasion.

Shoppers must make an appointment by calling 304-241-1863. Times are available 2-7 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday and 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Friday and Saturday. The shop is closed on Sundays and Mondays.

Lavish does not provide alterations on-site but can make recommendations of talented local seamstresses.

Squires takes care to provide a safe and hygienic environment for her patrons, by cleaning surfaces between appointments and applying fabric sanitizer to garments, and practicing social distancing.







West Virginia products were used, including flooring from Greenbrier County, stained glass in the tower from Milton and bricks from the Eastern Panhandle. Construction was funded through private contributions and bond debt that was assumed by the [WVU Alumni] Association. The new facility was created to help the WVU Alumni Association grow with an expanding alumni base and to support needs within the Morgantown community for a mid-size event space."

Named after Charles F. Erickson and the Erickson family, a philanthropist and advocate for higher education, the center is owned by the WVU Alumni Association and operated by staff employed by WVU.

There are 14 rentable spaces within the center and three outside, all ranging in size. Rental information is available by calling 304-293-4731, emailing eacevents@ mail.wvu.edu or checking out ericksonalumnicenter.com.

All catering is handled by the center and can include everything from hors d'oeuvres to plated meals or buffets.

Staff will work with clients to determine the best options for guest numbers ranging from 10 to 1,000.




