WVU meets North Carolina in Duke's Mayo Bowl

Mountaineers looking to win 9 games for 1st time since 2016

It's been over four weeks since either West Virginia or North Carolina have played a football game. A lot has happened in that time, the transfer portal has opened, conference championships have been played and players have declared for the NFL Draft.

The two teams that match up in this year's Duke's Mayo Bowl (5:30 p.m./ESPN) in Charlotte, N.C. are different than the teams that last played on Nov. 25.

"We'll be a little bit different than when we played at Baylor, but I don't know if that's all bad," WVU head coach Neal Brown said. "And North Carolina probably feels the same way."

The Mountaineers (8-4, 6-3 Big 12) will be without leading rusher CJ Donaldson (injury), starting center Zach Frazier (injury/draft) and starting defensive tackle Mike Lokchart (transfer), as well as several depth players who entered the transfer portal.

The Tar Heels (8-4, 4-4 ACC) are missing star quarterback Drake Maye (draft), starting center Corey Gaynor and top receiver Tez Walker (draft) as well as its top two tight ends (injury).

"North Carolina has had a few opt outs and they have a few guys in the portal, just like everybody in the country right now," Brown said. "But I also think in bowl games, it goes to the team that's most excited. They're going to play a lot of new guys in the game and those guys are going to be really excited."

North Carolina heads into the bowl game on the tail end of a disappointing season. UNC was picked to finish third in the ACC led by Maye, one of the top quarterbacks in the country.

The first half of the season went off without a hitch as the Tar Heels started 6-0 and were ranked No. 10 in the country. They went 2-4 in the second half, however, with their only wins coming against FCS

Campbell and Duke in double overtime.

While watching film, Brown said he couldn't identify what caused UNC's sudden reversal of fortune, instead deferring the question to Mack Brown, his septuagenarian counterpart.

"That's probably a question for them," WVU's Brown said. "I see a group that's talented. I think they're dangerous

In the Mayo Bowl, Hold the Maye-0

WVU will not face North Carolina star QB Drake Maye

It's nearly impossible to watch North Carolina's offense this season and imagine what it would be like without quarterback Drake Maye.

Maye, one of the top signal-callers in the country and a projected top pick in the NFL Draft, did it all for the UNC offense. He threw all but eight of the team's 433 pass attempts this season for 3,608 yards and 24 touchdowns and was also the team's second-leading rusher with 449 yards and nine scores.

Maye is so highly considered for the draft that he opted out of the team's Duke's Mayo Bowl appearance against West Virginia (5:30 p.m./ESPN).

"Maye is special, he's going to be the

first or second quarterback taken in the draft," WVU coach Neal Brown said.

While it is difficult to evaluate UNC's offense knowing Maye won't be a part of it, there is a silver lining.

"I'm super excited that I don't have to scout them knowing that he's playing," WVU co-defensive coordinator ShaDon Brown said. "Great player, probably will be the first over second pick overall. He had an unbelievable career at North Carolina."

In Maye's place, redshirt freshman Conner Harrell will be making his first career start.

"I'm blessed to have the opportunity, blessed to be in this position. I have to take advantage of it," Harrell said. "I have

WVU rushing game vs UNC rushing defense

West Virginia led all of Power Five with 234.3 rushing yards per game. The Mountaineers ran for more than 200 yards in seven games, including three over 300, and were never held to less than 150. The combination of running backs CJ Donaldson and Jahiem White and quarterback Garrett Greene proved lethal all season as all three eclipsed 700 yards this season. North Carolina's run defense collapsed in the second half of the season, allowing 234.4 yards per game against their final five FBS opponents.

WVU rushing defense vs UNC rushing game

North Carolina's Omarion Hampton led the ACC with 1,442 rushing yards and 15 touchdowns this season. There was little depth behind him, however, as quarterback Drake Maye, who will not play, was second on the team with 449 yards and backup British Brooks was third with 318. No one else had more than 100 yards for the year. While mostly solid, the Mountaineers' rush defense struggled against high-caliber backs this season. Oklahoma State's Ollie Gordon ran for 282, Texas Tech's Tajh Brooks had 149 and Oklahoma's Gavin Sawchuk had 135.

WVU passing game vs UNC passing defense

North Carolina was last in the ACC in pass defense (242.3 yards per game) but fourth with a dozen interceptions. The Mountaineers ran the ball so well this year, they rarely aired it out all that much and only averaged 203.8 yards per game, last in the Big 12. Quarterback Garrett Greene was also careful with the ball, only throwing four interceptions across 362 attempts.

WVU passing defense vs UNC passing game

North Carolina's Drake Maye was one of the best quarterbacks in the nation this season and he has opted out of the bowl game to pursue the NFL. That leaves redshirt freshman Conner Harrell to make his first career start. UNC is also without top receiver Tez Walker, who is also going pro. WVU's pass defense was the definition of inconsistency. Six times they held opponents under 230 passing yards, six times they gave up more than 230.

Advantage: WVU



Special teams

UNC was 21-23 on field goals this year while WVU was 14-17. Neither team made one from further than 50 yards. Both teams were below average in the return game, although UNC's Alijah Huzzie had a punt return touchdown. WVU allowed three kick-off return touchdowns and UNC gave up one. WVU's Oliver Straw has a slight edge at punter over UNC's Tom Maginness, although both were solid this season.

A flash of White

Freshman running back Jahiem White ended the season on an absolute tear. He averaged 121.4 rushing yards per game over WVU's last five weeks, including a 204-yard performance against Cincinnati.

Stay on the attack

WVU's offense averaged 35.3 points over its last seven games thanks, in large part, to aggressive play-calling and explosive plays from quarterback Garrett Greene.

Thinning ranks

Due to injuries and transfers, the Mountaineers are going to be very thin at line-backer, defensive back, running back and wide receiver. That will cause added strain on special teams, where underclassmen will man most of the positions.

Replacing Maye

Conner Harrell is no Drake Maye, but that doesn't mean he's not talented. Despite very limited playing time as Maye's backup this year, Harrell did score two long touchdowns, a 41-yard throw and a 61-yard run.

The replacements

Maye won't be the only contributor missing for UNC. Leading receiver Tez Walker (699 yards, seven touchdowns), leading tackler Cedric Gray (121 tackles, 11 TFL) and starting center Corey Gaynor have all also opted out.

Getting back on track

UNC started the season 6-0, but went 2-4 down the stretch. The Tar Heels' only wins in the second half of the season were against FCS Campbell and a double-overtime win over Duke.

because they have some new people playing. I think that's underrated, especially in the bowl season. Everybody pays attention to who's not playing, but all these other guys have got new opportunities. We're going to see some new players."

Something that jumps off the page about North Carolina's second half of the season is a porous run defense. In its last five games against FBS competition, opponents averaged 234.4 rushing yards against UNC. Ironically, West Virginia averaged 234.3 yards per game as the top rushing attack in the country this season.

With the extended layoff between games, however, Brown said there will be a focus on maintaining the team's physicality needed to have rushing success.

"We're a running football team," Brown said. "We need to get our work in while being cognizant of we're not being too physical."

The benefit to the time off has been some much-needed time to rest and recover following the 12-week regular season.

"Off time is good, we definitely needed it," WVU quarterback Garrett Greene said. "The first practice back, our wide

receivers had a little different gear to them because they have fresh legs. As we near the game, it gets more critical on the attention to detail and getting back to what we were successful at."

Greene was one of three 70-yards rushers for WVU this season, joined by Donaldson and true freshman Jahiem White,

who will start the game with Donaldson injured.

Defensively, North Carolina caused a lot of turnover this season, snagging 12 interceptions and recovering nine fumbles.

"If you look at the teams that lost (bowl games), there were a lot of turnovers,"

Brown said. "The flip side of that on defense is missed tackles."

Missed tackles could come into play because, like the Mountaineers, North Carolina also liked to run the football this season. Sophomore Omarion Hampton was named first-team All-ACC after rushing for 1,442 yards and 15 touchdowns this year.

"Their running back is a really, really good player," Brown said. "We've played some really good running backs this year, but he's as good as any that we've played."

"It is a challenge. We're not tackling (in practice). We're trying to be as physical as we can while keeping people off the ground."

The Mountaineers are looking for their first bowl win since 2020 and just their second since 2016. A win would also give them nine wins this season, a mark not reached since that 2016 season.

"This is our first time to get to nine wins a couple years, so this is a big deal," White said. "We're very excited to get out there and play against North Carolina in North Carolina."

UNC meanwhile wants to end the year on a positive note with some momentum going into 2024. The Tar Heels have made five straight bowl games, but have dropped three straight since last winning in 2019.

to take advantage of every day, every practice.”

Harrell saw very little playing time backing up Maye this season. He threw six passes for 71 yards and a touchdown and ran five times for 50 yards.

“He didn’t really have too many plays this year so we’ve had to watch some of his high school highlights,” WVU cornerback Beanie Bishop admitted. “The guy can run, so they might try to change up the gameplan a little bit to try to get him into rhythm.”

Wednesday can be thought of as an early audition for Harrell as he tries to get a head start on UNC’s quarterback competition for 2024. His main competition will be Texas A&M transfer Max Johnson.

“When you’re playing these games, there’s going to be some energy around (Harrell) playing,” Neal Brown said. “This is an opportunity for him on a good stage. They brought in a transfer quarterback and I guarantee he’s using this to say ‘hey, you might be bringing a transfer here, but I’m here and this is my job.’”

“When you think about him, two things stick out,” Neal Brown said. “First thing is he’s a big kid that’s really fast,

second thing is he throws the deep ball really well.”

Harrell shares a lot of attributes with WVU starter Garrett Greene, who is also a dynamic runner and throws a nice deep ball. Does that mean the Tar Heels will ditch what they were doing with Maye and all of a sudden look more like the Mountaineers on Wednesday? Not necessarily.

“Are they going to look the exact same they did when they had Drake Maye at quarterback? I don’t know,” Brown said. “They’re not going to ask their o-line to do a bunch of different things, but I definitely think they’re going to have some quarterback run game and I can see them throwing the ball off some play action stuff and getting the ball down field.”

Maye isn’t the only big name missing from UNC’s offensive depth chart as starting center Corey Gaynor and top receiver Tez Walker have also opted out of the game and set their sights on turning pro. Considering that both of the team’s top tight ends will also miss the game, both with injury, and the Tar Heels could look a lot different, personnel-wise, than the team that played 12 games this year.

“You watch who they are,” ShaDon Brown said. “We’re trying to figure out who they are, not personnel driven, but who are they offensively and what do they like to do.”

Mountaineers squeak by Tar Heels in Meineke Car Care Bowl

Dec. 27, 2008 - WVU 31, North Carolina 30

CHARLOTTE, N.C. — 15 years ago to the day, Pat White ended his historic West Virginia career with his fourth bowl victory as the Mountaineers' starting quarterback, a dramatic 31-30 win over North Carolina in the then-named Meineke Car Care Bowl.

Today, West Virginia faces the same opponent, with the same records, at the same location in the same bowl game, albeit with a new name.

In 2008, the 8-4 Mountaineers met the 8-4 Tar Heels in what would be the final game of White's college career. It was a fitting finale, too, as White, the most prolific running quarterback in college football history up to that point, had the best passing day of his career.

White threw for a career-high 332 yards, including the game-winning 20-yard touchdown to Alric Arnett midway through the fourth quarter.

"Knowing that this is the last time I'm going to put on this uniform, I definitely wanted to go out on top," White said after the game. "We accomplished that."

It took a great performance for WVU to beat out future NFL receiver Hakeem Nicks, who caught eight passes for 217 yards and three touchdowns.

UNC quarterback T.J. Yates' otherwise strong game was marred when he was intercepted by Pat Lazear with under two minutes left.

White completed 26 of 32 passes with three touchdowns, one interception, and a clutch fourth-quarter drive.

After West Virginia's J.T. Thomas

recovered Shaun Draughn's fumble at the Mountaineers 30, White threw a 41-yard pass over the middle to Jock Sanders, picked up nine yards on a running play and then rifled a pass between two defenders to Arnett for the go-ahead touchdown with 7:14 left.

"He was on target on everything," Arnett said. "That's the type of player he is. He's going to make a play with his arm or with his legs."

The Mountaineers were missing starting defensive backs Brandon Hogan and Sidney Glover to injuries and illness. The 6-foot-1 Nicks, playing in his hometown,

responded by setting three school receiving records and shattering his career-high in yards receiving -- before the game was 20 minutes old. It was part of a dizzying offensive display by both teams that had six touchdowns on the board with 10:37 left in the second quarter.

White completed 14 of his first 15 passes and threw two first-half touchdowns, including a remarkable one-handed grab by Arnett for a 44-yard score. But White was intercepted in the end zone at the end of the first half by Deunta Williams, who had earlier tackled Noel Devine in the end zone for a safety.

With the victory, White became the first quarterback in the history of college football to start and win four bowl games, a feat that has still not been matched since. White was named MVP of the Car Care Bowl, the year he took home bowl MVP honors.

"I'm sitting by the greatest winner in college football today," then-West Virginia coach Bill Stewart said of White. "He's the greatest to ever wear the old gold and blue. It's a fitting tribute that this man's the MVP."

While there are many similarities between the 2023 Duke's Mayo Bowl and the 2008 Meineke Car Care Bowl, the one key difference is that the teams are playing opposite roles.

Despite winning the bowl to finish 9-4, Stewart's first season as WVU head coach was widely seen as a disappointment.

"Half those people out there in the old gold and blue, they all love (White)," Stewart said. "But half of them would like to hang me...But I'm not mad. They have such a passion in West Virginia. All they want us to do is be the best."

North Carolina's 8-5 finish, on the other hand, was seen as a successful turnaround campaign in coach Butch Davis' second season.

In 2023, it's the Tar Heels (8-4, 4-4 ACC) who are feeling disappointment. After starting the year 6-0 with one of the best quarterbacks in the country in Drake Maye, UNC went 2-4 in the second half of the season.

WVU (8-4, 6-3), meanwhile, is enjoying a turnaround season in Neal Brown's fifth year at the helm.
